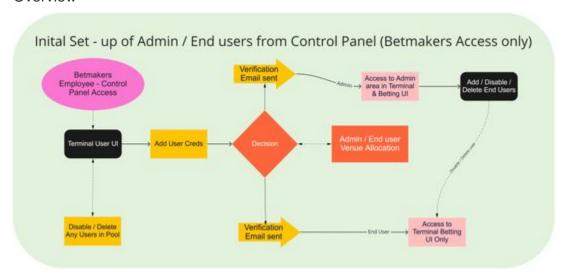
Terminal Users - Control Panel - (INTERNAL)

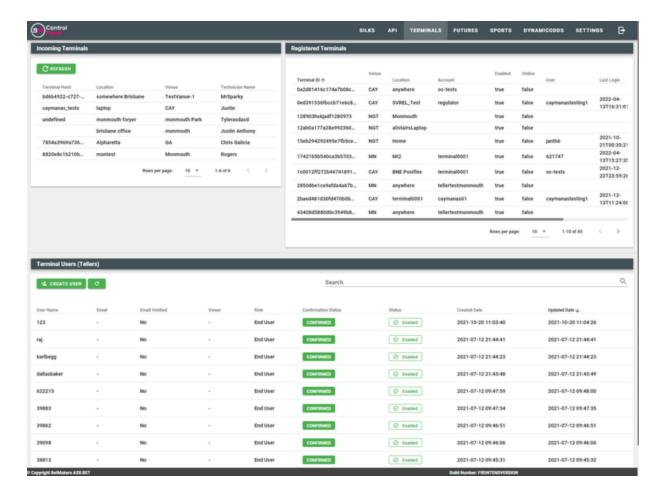


Modal 1: Navigate to Terminals Control

Login to the Betmakers Control Panel and Navigate to the Terminals Page, by using the tabs at the top. - If you don't see any tabs you need to request access from a Betmakers Administrator.



Once here you will see the following UI.



Scroll down to Terminal Users (Tellers)



Modal 2: Creating Users

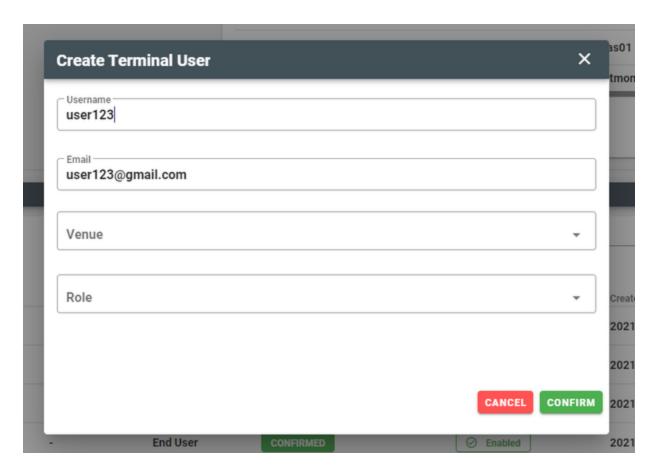
The following process is for setting up Admins and End users for each venue that the terminals are allocated.

Click Create User

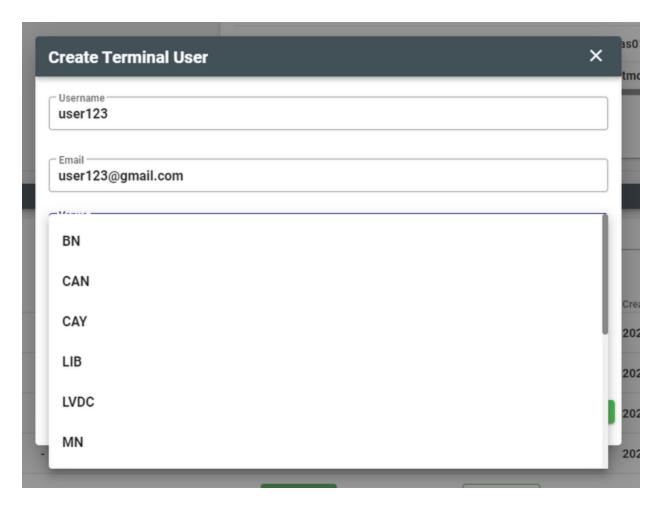


Enter User credentials - please note each user must be unique with a unique email address.

The Email address must be Validated by the User (see documentation - User Setup Instructions)



Select a Venue - Ensure you select ONLY the venue that is applicable



Select Role



Admins - Users that have this Role will be granted permission to add / delete

/ disable Users according to the Venue that was selected in the terminal admin portal - https://oncourseterminal.betmakers.com/admin

End User - Users that have this Role will be granted access ONLY to the 4x3 Terminal Software once they have completed the validation process (see

document - User Setup Instructions)

If the User is required to change Roles the account must be deleted and re-

instated with the new Role Selected

Click Confirm once done.

In the below list you will now see the latest user you have added.

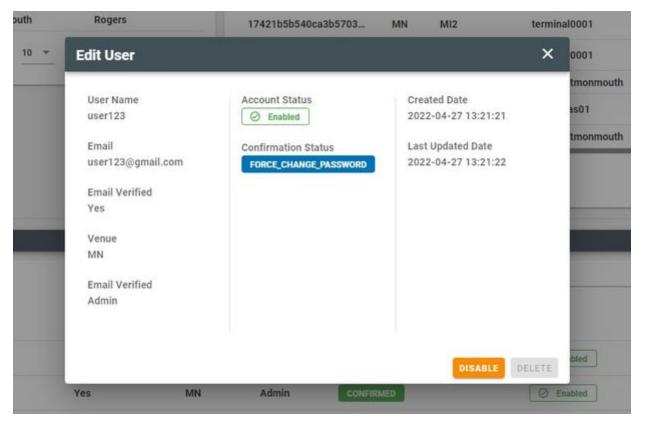


This user needs to confirm their Email address and Password prior to accessing the Terminal interfaces..

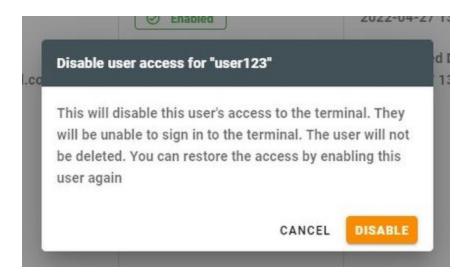
You can also see the status of ALL users here for ALL Venues.



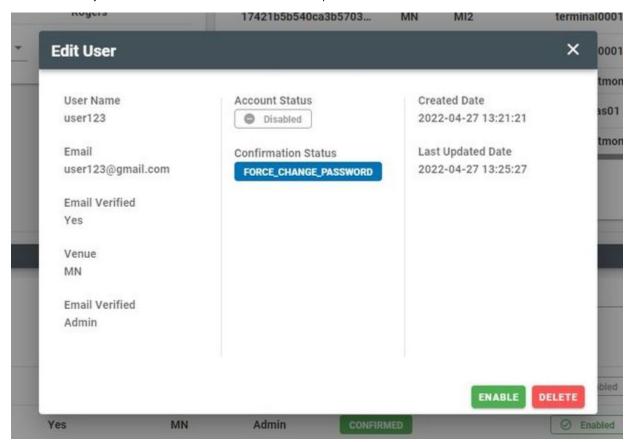
To Disable this User click on the list item to access the following modal



Click Disable



To Delete a User you must first Disable the User then the Delete option will be available.



Once deleted, if the user is required again they will have to follow the validation process again.

Enabling the User will require no intervention by the User, they will immediately be granted access again.
